Loyal staff with 435 years' service recognised by SBW

Long serving staff with more than 430 years' loyal service between them have been recognised by Sembcorp Bournemouth Water (SBW).

A total of 21 employees were presented with awards by Managing Director Roger Harrington at the company's headquarters.

The longest-serving, Ian Randall, has been with SBW for more than 35 years while the others had served 10, 15, 20, 25 and 30 years.

In total, the 21 staff had clocked up 435 years with the company which supplies drinking water to approximately half a million people in parts of Dorset, Hampshire and Wiltshire.

Mr Harrington said he was very proud of the loyalty shown by such a large number of staff.

He added: "Sembcorp Bournemouth Water provides an essential service to the public which requires long term planning, consistency and high standards.

"We really value the knowledge, experience and loyalty of these members of staff who, in some cases, have dedicated their whole working life to the provision of a service which none of us can do without."
