A long-standing supporter of the Jigsaw Appeal at the Royal Bournemouth Hospital has received official recognition.

Sembcorp Bournemouth Water (SBW), which supplies drinking water to half a million people, has supported various Jigsaw Appeals since 2003.

The company has now been presented with a new gold certificate after donating £250 to the latest appeal.

Organisers hope to raise £1.5 million to transform the hospital's Women's Health Unit, allowing all breast and gynaecological services to be relocated onto one site.

SBW also sponsors the annual Tree of Light, organised by the Rotary Club of Boscombe and Southbourne, which raises funds for the Jigsaw Appeal.
