Objectives

- Appreciate the importance of saving water.
- Think of ways of saving water in our everyday lives.

Activities

How can we save water at home?

Look at the picture on the activity sheets to initiate a discussion about saving water in the home. Water saving ideas could include:

- 1. Take a shower not a bath
- 2. Mend dripping taps
- 3. Don't let water run when brushing your teeth
- 4. Use a hog bag in the toilet cistern
- 5. Only use dishwasher when full use economy programmes
- 6. Only use washing machine when full use economy programmes
- 7. Ensure no leaks in pipes in house or from mains to house
- 8. Collect rainwater in water butt to water the garden
- 9. Use watering can not a sprinkler
- 10. Water plants late in the evening
- 11. Use recycled water for washing the car

Also discuss how you could save water at school.

Suggested approach

- Encourage the children to think about how much water they use in one day.
- Use the activity sheet to initiate a discussion on ways of saving water.
- Use our Key Stage 3 materials on this subject to organise a water audit estimating how much water is used during one day in their household.
