Demolition and Site Clearance

It was a significant moment when the demolition of George Jessel House began. Built in the early 1960s, it used to be the busy administration center for Bournemouth Water. Unfortunately, the building had become unstable and, following the relocation of the administration team, the best thing to do was knock it down.

Our contractors, Galliford Try did a tremendous job and have since been very busy clearing the site ready for the construction phase. So far, they've cleared an incredible 10,000 tons of material from the site that's over 300 lorry loads! 99% of the waste has been recycled.



Construction

Moving forward, we're very pleased to announce that we've chosen Kier as the main construction contractors. They'll be busy over the next few months carrying out site surveys, excavation work and further ground clearance. Their main site offices will be arriving around the beginning of August, and at the same time, the piling works will begin.

Plan Amendment

We've also been out and about in the community, listening to what you have to say about the proposed plans. We're taking your comments on board and are looking to reduce the overall size of the buildings and the visual effect on the area. We'll be submitting amendments to the plan soon.
