## Demolition and Site Clearance

We have finally said goodbye to George Jessel House. The former headquarters of Bournemouth Water has now been completely cleared and the site will be home to the rest of the temporary works offices and welfare units which will be arriving soon.

Our contractor, Kier, have been busy with further site clearance of other redundant buildings and installing the piling mats for the 600 concrete piles, which are bored into the ground up to 18m deep, and will carry the load of the heavy tanks. The coming months will also see the beginning of the installation of underground pipes for the new water treatment process – these are one metre wide!
