Hello and welcome to your spring update about the upgrade of our Alderney Water Treatment Works

## What we've been doing:

The main foundations of the new treatment process buildings have now been laid, and we've started installing some of the structures and pipework.

We've recently welcomed the newest member of our team – a 37m high tower crane! It will perform over 5,000 lifting operations during the construction.

## Next steps in the coming months:

Parts of the buildings are being made offsite and will then fit together like a jigsaw once delivered.

Electrical parts and pipework are being put in place, and the specialist water treatment equipment is being produced at our suppliers.

## In your community:

We've visited local schools and Bournemouth University to promote careers in construction and Science, Technology, Engineering and Mathematics (STEM). In March, we hosted an 'Open Doors' week onsite. Engineering students visited the project to learn first-hand what it's like to work in construction on large infrastructure projects.
